Matthew 19:4-6 NLT

“Haven’t you read the Scriptures?” Jesus replied. “They record that from the beginning ‘God made them male and female.’” And he said, “‘This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.’ Since they are no longer two but one, let no one split apart what God has joined together.”

1. Grows together spiritually.

John 17:23 NLT

I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me.

2. Esteems one another in humility.

Ephesians 4:2-3 NKJ

...with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

3. Encourages one another regularly.

Ephesians 4:29 NKJ

Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

Ephesians 4:29 NLT

...Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

4. Dreams together continually.

5. Commits to one another daily.

Psalms 133:1-3 NLT
