Luke 5:1-4, 11 NIV

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God. He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat. When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." ... So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

1. He calls us.

Matthew 4:18-22 NKJV

Follow — to cleave steadfastly to one, <u>conform wholly to his example</u>, in living and if need be in dying also
