Three Important Things You Must Settle to Handle Money Well:

1. GOD IS THE OWNER - I AM THE MANAGER.

Three Levels of Control:

- 1. TOP LEVEL: GOD IS IN CONTROL OF ALL POSSESSIONS
- 2. SECOND LEVEL: YOU'RE IN CONTROL OF POSSESSIONS
- 3. BOTTOM LEVEL: POSSESSIONS ARE IN CONTROL OF YOU
- 2. SMALL THINGS ARE BIG THINGS

Three Areas of Faithfulness That Affect Our Finances:

- 1. Faithfulness in our COMMITMENTS
- 2. Faithfulness in our TIME.
