Qualifications for Access to His Presence:

1. Good Character

Blameless – Those who cannot be accused of wrongdoing before people or God

Righteous – To do what is required according to a standard

Proverbs 14:12 NLT

There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death.

Self-identify – To believe or assert that one belongs to a certain group or class

Psalm 15:3 NIV

2. Good Conduct with Others

Slander – To make a false and damaging statement about someone

Proverbs 10:18 NLT

Hiding hatred makes you a liar; slandering others makes you a fool.

Psalm 15:4 NIV
