2. In real Biblical community, people are CHANGED.

The Four Reasons the Enthusiasts Formed:

- 1. Because we are ignorant and short-sighted, and often unable to discern things that are excellent. But God reveals to one what is good for another so that in a multitude of counselors there is wisdom.
- 2. Because we are lovers of ourselves, unwilling to see our own errors; therefore, unlikely to fix them. Whereas our friends will, with a meek and impartial spirit, show us our faults.
- 3. Because we are weak and irresolute, and let go our integrity upon any opposition. But a band of friends who are like-minded inspire us with courage and confidence.
- 4. Because we are lukewarm in religious duties, but a holy fellowship will kindle and keep alive a holy fire.
- 3. In real Biblical community, people become FAMILY.
