Connect With Others

- o Have fun!
- Invite people to join your group
 - Friends & neighbors
 - During weekend services & Small Group Open House
- Encourage members to get to know each other, especially at the 1st meeting

Prepare Well

- Pray for your group members by name
- o Review & meditate on the material at least the day before
- o Encourage members to prepare each week
 - Watch messages
 - Read book

Facilitate Conversation

- Recap last week's session
- Use the questions located at the end of each chapter
- Watch the small group videos

• Share Your Experience

- Enter information in the LEADER TOOLBOX
 - Record attendance
 - Share stories of life change
