MATTHEW 19:1-6 NIV

When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went into the region of Judea to the other side of the Jordan. Large crowds followed him, and he healed them there. Some Pharisees

came to him to test him. They asked, "IS IT LAWFUL FOR A MAN TO DIVORCE HIS WIFE FOR ANY AND EVERY REASON?" Two Competing Value Systems:

CHRISTIAN:

Marriage based on covenant Meeting other's' needs Two people becoming one Goal is to please God Governed by the Word Committed for life **HUMANISTIC:**

Marriage based on feelings
Other person meeting your needs
Two people remaining independent
Goal is to please self
Governed by emotions and opinions
Divorce is an option

Covenant:

- Strongest word in the Bible describing both our relationship with God and with each other
- Reflects a solemn agreement between two parties in which there is total commitment by each party
- First truth to enter human consciousness
- Includes your life, your possessions, your children

GENESIS 17:1-7 NIV

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am God Almighty; walk before me faithfully and be blameless. Then I will make my COVENANT between me and you and will greatly increase your numbers." Abram fell facedown, and God said to him, "As for me, this is my COVENANT with you. You will

be the father of many nations. No longer will you be called Abram; your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations. I will make you very fruitful; I will make nations of you, and kings will come from you. I will establish my COVENANT as an everlasting COVENANT between me and you and your descendants after you for the generations to come, to be your God and the God of your descendants after you."

3 Kinds of Love:

1. Eros: physical love — found in your body

2. Phileo: emotional love — found in your soul

3. Agape: God's love — found in your spirit

3 Components of Love:

- 1. Passion: the desire that leads to romance, physical closeness, sex
- 2. Intimacy: involves closeness, like-mindedness, emotional bonding
- 3. Decision: commitment that encompasses short-term decision that "we love each other" with long-term commitment to maintain that love

1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-8 NLT
