Foundational Difference:

Unrepentant: “I choose what is good, right or best for me.”

Believer: “I choose what God says is good, right or best for me.”

Matthew 4:17 NLT

Jesus began to preach, “Repent of your sins and turn to God, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near.”

Matthew 11:20 NLT

Then Jesus began to denounce the towns where he had done so many of his miracles, because they hadn’t repented of their sins and turned to God.

Luke 13:3 NLT

“You will perish, too, unless you repent of your sins and turn to God.”

Mark 6:12 NLT

So the disciples went out, telling everyone they met to repent of their sins and turn to God.

Luke 16:30 NLT
