# **Differences Between Happiness and Joy:**

**Happiness:** depends on favorable circumstances

Joy: independent of circumstances

Happiness: based on feelings

Joy: based on the power of the Holy Spirit

Happiness: leaves you in times of trouble

Joy: guides you in times of trouble

Happiness: connected to the state of relationships—finances—

health-career

Joy: connected to the state of your relationship with God

**Happiness:** temporal

Joy: eternal

Happiness: leaves you always wanting more

Joy: leaves you always fulfilled

# **How to Activate the Power of Joy:**

1. Make an influence shift.

2. Get your thought life under control.
